Communion Reflection... It's not easy to convert the rich. It's like this. The more people have, the more they have to lose. The more they have to lose, the more fearful they become. The result is that they end up with a withered heart. And it's impossible to breathe life into a withered heart. To close one's heart is to begin to die. To open one's heart is to begin to live. At the end of the day it's not what we carry in our purses or bank accounts that matters. It's what we carry in our hearts. That is where the rich are found wanting. Poverty of heart is the worst form of poverty.

National Day for Truth & Reconciliation - Sept 30, 2022



Cathedral Basilica with participation from Indigenous members of the community. All are welcome in person or via livestream at: www.stmichaelscathedral.com/live/.

Life Chain is a peaceful and silent witness to the injustice of abortion and the harm it inflicts on women and the community at large. It is a simple but powerful reminder to our fellow citizens of the sanctity of human life and our duty to defend the weakest members of our society. The very first Life Chain was held in 1987 in Yuba City, California and consisted of 2,500 people. The annual event grew by leaps and bounds in the following years, with Canada holding its first Life Chain in 1990, and almost 1,000,000 participating across North America in 1992. Most Life Chains will be held on Sun. Oct. 2. Join one in front of the **Giant Tiger mall in Bolton** (East side of Hwy 50 from 4-5 pm) or on Sandalwood Pkwy E at **Torbram Rd (St. Marguerite d'Youville Church)** from 2-3 pm.
